

How to Add and Verify Your Domain for Apple Business Manager or Apple School Manager





Apple requires that you verify the domain or domains associated with your Managed Apple IDs. This guide shows you how to verify one of your existing domains.



2. Click on your account (your name on the bottom-left).

3. Select Preferences.

4. Click Accounts





5. Under Domians, click Edit.

11. Open TextEdit, open a new blank document if necessary, and paste in the copied TXT record. You'll need this for a later step.

NOTE: If you have a domain named hcsonline.com and a second domain listed as hcsonlinecom. appleid.com you will need two TXT records. Some domain providers show the TXT record as @. Two TXT records cannot contain the same name or symbol so use @ for the primary domain and use a name for the second domain. I.E. appleid.

- 12. Create a DNS TXT record at your domain registrar. This procedure will vary depending on your domain registrar. If you are using one of the following services, see their documentation for creating a TXT record in a zone file, or contact your DNS administrator:
 - Google: Verify your domain with a TXT record
 - GoDaddy: <u>Add a TXT record</u>
 - Microsoft Azure: Add a TXT record for verification
 - Network Solutions: Managing Advanced DNS Records
 - NameCheap: How do I add TXT record for my domain?

If you have a different domain registrar, contact them for information on how to add a TXT record to your DNS zone file. As an example, this guide uses Site Ground.



- 13. After you log in to Site Ground, go to the Cpanel for DNS settings.
- 14. Select Advanced DNS Zone Editor.



- 15. Create a TXT record. Paste in the value that you copied in step 10.
- 16. Log out of your domain registrar.

17. Check the email account that is tied to the Apple Business Manager or Apple School Manager account that you signed in with. In the verification email message, click the Verify Ownership.





18. To test your DNS TXT record, Open Terminal then enter the following command:

dig -t txt yourdomaingoeshere.com

The results will return the TXT record you created at your domain registrar.

NOTE: It can take up to 24 hours for the new DNS record to propagate across the internet.

- 20. Go to the domains section, then click Check Now.
