

How to Install TeamViewer Host with Jamf Pro



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Section 1: Configuring a TeamViewer Host Package

In this section we will configure a custom TeamViewer Host Package that will automatically add a computer to a group in TeamViewer. To follow along with this section you will need administrative access to your TeamViewer management console.

NOTE: Be sure to sign in with an account that owns the group you want to add your computers to. If you sign into the TeamViewer Management Console and you don't see any groups in the Groups section, you are not using the correct account.

1. In a web browser, go to https://login.teamviewer.com.

2. Enter your TeamViewer Administration account.

3. Click Sign In.

 - A. Click the Title Icon and enter a title for your host.
 - B. Click the Logo icon and select your logo.
 - C. Text, Text Color, and Background Color are optional.
 - D. Name: Enter a name, this guide will use HCS Support.
 - E. Automatically add users to a group in your contacts List: Enabled
 - F. Select a group from the menu. This guide will use HCS-NY
 - G. TeamViewer Policy: Select Inherit from group
 - H. Allow account assignment: Enabled
 - I. Allow customer to initiate a service case: Enabled
 - J. Select a group from the dropdown menu. This guide will use HCS-NY
 - K. Default Assignee: Select an account that owns the group that you want the computer to go into. This guide will use HCS Technology Group.
 - L. Click Save

Section 2: Creating a Custom TeamViewer Host Package

In this section we will configure a custom TeamViewer Host package that will automatically add a computer to a group in TeamViewer. To follow along with this section, you will need the following:

- Jamf Composer
- A choices xml file to silently install the TeamViewer Host package. You can download a pre-configured choices.xml file from: https://github.com/HCSTech/Files/blob/main/HCS%20TeamVeiwer%20Files.zip

1. Confirm you have the following items in your Downloads folder:

- HCS TeamViewer Files
- TeamViewer_PKG

7. Open your Downloads folder and move it to the right of the tmp folder so the two folders are side by side. Open the HCS TeamViewer Files folder and select the choices.xml file. Hold the option key and drag the choices.xml file to the tmp folder on the left. This makes a copy of the file in the tmp folder.

Section 3: Deploying TeamViewer Host with Jamf Pro

This section will guide you through uploading the TeamViewer Host package to your Jamf Pro server and creating a policy and script for installing TeamViewer Host. To follow along with this section, you will need the following:

- Administrative access to your Jamf Pro server.
- The TeamViewer Host package created in section 2 of this guide. This file should be on your Desktop.
- The assign_teamviewer.sh script that was downloaded in section 2 of this guide. This file should be located in your Downloads folder in a folder named HCS TeamViewer Files.
- 1. Open a web browser of your choosing and log in to your Jamf Pro server with administrative credentials.



- 2. Click Settings (③) in top right corner.
- 3. Click on Computer Management.
- 4. Click Packages.
